Anti Gay Groups

State that LGBT (Lesbian, Gay, Bisexual and Transgender) people sinful and anti-Christian.

EDL - English Defence League

Street protest movement consisting of white English people who want to protect traditional English values against the spread of Islamism in the UK. They have been described as Islamophobic. (against the religion of Islam)

HASCIS

Headteachers Against Sensible Clothes In Schools

A group of Headteachers from Norfolk who believe in the freedom to wear outrageous clothes in school whenever they want.

Be careful they are quietly recruiting in your area.

ISIS / Daesh

A terrorist group who are currently attempting to recruit people around the world to either move to Iraq and Syria to join their movement or carry out acts of terrorism in their own countries.

Radicalisation

Process by which an individual or group comes to adopt increasingly extreme political, social, or religious ideals

How do extremists recruit ?

- Social media - Facebook and Twitter to share content, such as news stories and videos, among peer groups.
- Youtube is used to host videos
- Instagram is used by fighters and ISIL supporters to share the photo sets frequently used by ISIL media organisations.
- Tumblr is an online blogging site and is used by ISIL fighters Private messaging apps, such as WhatsApp, Kik, SureSpot and Viber
