



***Romeo and Juliet*, THURSDAY 31st January 2019 THEATRE ROYAL NORWICH**

Dear Parents/Carers

As part of your child's GCSE Literature, our class is studying several texts, one of which is *Romeo and Juliet*.

We are in the fortunate position of being able to coincide the time we are studying this with a production of the play at Theatre Royal Norwich. This is fantastic timing as their exam is just 5 months after this performance.

In classes, we read the play in Year 9 and consolidated our closer analysis and understanding of the text in Year 10. Seeing a live production of this is a superb form of revision which we are rarely able to offer on our doorstep.

The opportunity to further enhance your child's comprehension of this play with being able to see it on a stage production would greatly enhance their understanding of how Shakespeare intended this - a play to be seen by an audience.

While we consider this visit to be an important part of studying this text, any children who we believe, due to poor behaviour could cause a Health and Safety risk, will not be allowed to participate. The decision will be made by myself and Mr Ogle. If we decide that your child's behaviour has changed before the trip, we reserve the right to advise you that your child will no longer be on the trip.

The cost of the trip will be £22.

The itinerary is as follows:

Leave Norwich:	2200
Approximate arrival APHS:	2300 (please bear in mind this is approximate)

We are asking for a non-refundable deposit of £10 by September 30th. If you wish your child to attend the trip, please complete the enclosed consent form and pay via cheque or cash in a sealed envelope, with your child's name on the back, with your child's name and form written on the envelope.

You are then asked to pay the remainder of £12 online via the Online Payment System by October 20th. Of course - you are free to pay the entire cost in one payment by September 30th should this suit your circumstances.



If your child is eligible for the pupil premium grant, then the cost will be covered by this funding, however you STILL need to return the permission slip.

TRANSPORT ARRANGEMENTS - please read carefully.
